FCC Emergency Broadband Benefit

The FCC Emergency Broadband Benefit program can help make home internet more affordable during the COVID-19 pandemic. Qualifying households will receive up to **\$50 per month** towards broadband service (or **\$75 per month** for households on [qualifying Tribal lands](#)). In addition, households can also receive a **one-time credit of up to \$100** to help buy a device like a computer or tablet when they contribute more than \$10 and less than \$50 toward the purchase price.
